- Maps detailing location, size and individual identification of all pastures plus the locations of permanent fences, shade and water. You may provide a satellite image of each parcel to show the locations and sources of shade and water.
- Pasture Management Plan
- Ration plans for all classes of animals over six months of age for all ration periods

Copies of the applicable portions of an organic system plan may be included with your application as long as they contain all the information requested in the OPT Certified Grass-Fed Organic Livestock Program System Plan.

The basic program fee of \$300 must be submitted with the application. Please return completed application documents via your preferred communication preference (e.g. postal or

PCO portal).
